



**Diagnostic Assessments for the
Workplace: SASC Authorised**



This course is for diagnostic assessors who want to extend their practice into the workplace

Introduction

The vast majority of people with dyslexia will be in the workplace. This course enables diagnostic assessors to extend their practice into the workplace.

Course Description

On the course delegates will examine how to make recommendation to reports written for University students to transfer to the workplace. They will learn how to advise employers on making reasonable adjustment to comply with good practice, which makes their companies more successful commercially, and understand both the legal requirements with regards to the Equality Act, and the way Access to Work functions.

It will include:

- Adding recommendations to a DSA report for the workplace
- Diagnostic assessments for the workplace – what is similar to DSA reports and what are the differences
- Legal framework (Equality Act, 2010)
- Access to work
- Reasonable adjustments and strategies
- Workplace needs assessments

Course Outcome

Delegates will understand the legal framework affecting employees with SpLDs in the workplace and understand the Access to Work scheme. They will be able to identify how a diagnostic report can be adapted for the workplace, and identify appropriate recommendations for reasonable adjustments and strategies. They will understand what is different about a workplace needs assessment.

Eligibility - Delegates will be expected to be working with (or planning to work with) adults in the workplace.
